



The **Certified Occupational Safety Specialist (COSS®)** course has obtained approval from the [Department of Veterans Affairs](#) for partial reimbursement for the **COSS Class!**

Active duty military personnel, veterans, and their family members who complete(d) the **COSS** course, **after January 1, 2008**, will be pleased to learn that they may be eligible for partial reimbursement of the cost of the class through **The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)**. However, only eligible recipients who took the COSS course after **January 1, 2008** will qualify for the reimbursement.

The VA has agreed to reimburse eligible COSS graduates up to \$1185 if they apply for education benefits within a year of taking the course. Please be advised that graduates must meet certain qualifications set forth by the VA in order to seek the reimbursement. General information about VA reimbursement for educational benefits for veterans is available at the VA website at www.gibill.va.gov.

Complete instructions on how to apply for the reimbursement are listed in the [VA Brochure](#). When submitting *your* reimbursement request to the VA, COSS graduates **must use the approval facility code**, which is **46-0032-05**. Because Pacific Safety Council originated the request from the VA, their physical address must be used as the "administrative location", regardless of where the COSS course was actually taken.
